PRE-SEASON POOL HOURS: (May 29-June 3)

May 29	11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
May 30	12:00 to 8:00 p.m.
May 31	11:00 to 9:00 p.m.
June 1	Closed
June 2 – June 3	4:00 to 8:00 p.m.

SEASON POOL HOURS: (June 4-August 22)

Monday – Closed except holidays (closed on Tuesday if Monday is a Holiday)

Tuesday - Saturday – 11:00 to 9:00 p.m.

Sunday – 12:00 to 8:00 p.m.

POST-SEASON POOL HOURS: (August 23-Sept. 6)

Monday – Closed except holidays (closed on Tuesday if Monday is a Holiday)

Tuesday – Friday 4:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Sunday 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

September 6th 11:00 to 9:00 p.m. (closes for season)

Pool Rules

1. **LIFEGUARDS ARE PROVIDED DURING POOL HOURS. SWIMMING IS NOT ALLOED AT ANY TIME OTHER THAN THE DESIGNATED POOL HOURS.**
2. No children under 12 years of age are permitted in the pool area without an adult over the age of 18. Any child who cannot swim must be accompanied by an adult in the water and/or wear a properly fitted U.S. Coastguard approved life vest.
3. Guests will be limited to no more than 2 guests per member. All guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.
4. No person with open abrasions or sores, skin disease, nasal or ear discharge or a communicable disease may swim.
5. No diving.
6. Do **NOT** swim alone.
7. No alcoholic beverages.
8. No smoking in the pool area.
9. No glass containers in the pool area.
10. Please shower or wipe off all oils and lotions before getting in the pool. It accumulates on the side of the pool creating a thick residue.

11. **NO DIAPERS IN POOL.** Non-potty trained children must wear **swim diapers**. Swim diapers are only allowed in the wading pool. There is to be **NO** diaper changing on the pool deck – **STATE LAW.**
12. No running or rough housing.
13. No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades or roller skates will be allowed in the pool area. They must be stored outside the pool area.
14. No rafts or inflatables are permitted.
15. Use of pool furniture is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
16. No furniture is allowed in the pools, period.
17. No pets allowed, with the exception of handicap guide dogs.
18. Appropriate swimwear only. No cutoffs.
19. No abusive language, loud radio or excessive noise.
20. Please pick up all belongings and deposit trash in designated trash receptacles.
21. The homeowners association assumes no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to personal property or effects left in pool area by residents or their guests.
22. The homeowners association assumes no responsibility for any personal injury to anyone resulting from the use of the pool.
23. Only residents of the community and their guests are permitted to use the pool facilities.
24. Walk, don't run
25. Pushing and rough play is prohibited
26. Keep off the lane lines and lane ropes
27. Adult supervision is required for all children 11 and under
28. No dunking or horseplay
29. Non-swimmers must stay in the shallow area
30. Feet first entries only
31. Lifeguard towers and safety equipment is for lifeguard use only
32. All swimmers under the age of 14 must pass the swim test to swim; all will have a green or red band on.
33. Inflatable swim aids are not allowed. **NO INFLATABLES!**
34. One person on the slide at a time.
35. Red bands may use the slide without or with a pfd
36. Kickboards may be used on Yellow slide only
37. Swim team kickboards are to be locked up and not allowed to the public.
38. Parents may catch their children on the yellow slide.
39. Swim Diapers are not allowed in the big pool or down the slide.

RULES AND REGULATIONS MAY BE AMENDED BY THE BOARD. VIOLATIONS TO THESE GUIDELINES MAY RESULT IN DISCONTINUED POOL PRIVILEGES AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD. GATES MUST REMAIN CLOSED AND LATCHED AT ALL TIMES
